

## 1. CLEAN THE AREA

Using a wet rag/microfiber, clean the inside of the door sill using soap and water if necessary.



## 2. START IN THE FRONT AND LAY THE BOTTOM PIECE FIRST

Remove the piece with an L shape cut out, line it up with the bottom of the door sill following the lines of the body, start from one side laying it down working your way to the other side ensuring no air bumbles are trapped underneath. Once the top portion is stuck on, the side facing away from the car will need to be

pushed down as well in the same manner as the top ensuring no air pockets are trapped under the vinyl.



## 3. PLACE THE TOP PIECE AND JOIN THE TWO TOETHER CAREFULLY TO NOT OVERLAY THE TWO



## 4. INSTALLING REAR DOOR SILLS

Remove the vinyl strip off the backing paper. Start with the bottom piece lay it down starting from one corner working to the other ensuring no air bubbles are trapped. Take another piece off the backing paper and over the top portion of the door sill just like on the front door joining the two pieces together.
